MASS INTENTIONS

The purpose of the Mass Intentions donation is to help pay for a priest; however, the priest can only keep one intention donation (\$15) a day. The extra money for multiple Mass Intentions are forwarded to the Diocese.

Bishop Damphousse has mandated that only three (3) Mass Intentions can be scheduled per Mass. The extra Intentions are donations to be forwarded to parishes that don't have any. Holy Redeemer is one such parish.

At Our Lady of Hope and St. Anthony's we have an abundance of Mass Intentions and will have to send them out. Thus, beginning June 1st, we will be implementing the Bishop's policy and sharing the wealth with neighbouring churches to help them pay for their priest. If you are affected, you'll receive a call.
